

# Vulcanus in Europe

## timeline

2016-2017

MAY / JUNE 2016

Call for expressions of interest, sent to industrial companies located in the European Union

SEPTEMBER 2016

**23 September 2016:** deadline to apply for the host companies. information on placements will be posted in our website

OCTOBER 2016

Short-listing of potential host companies, mainly on the basis of the content of the placement offered

NOVEMBER / DECEMBER 2016

Match -making process (the files of the students are sent to the potential host companies, who decide whether or not to accept their application)

JANUARY --> MARCH 2017

Signature of the Vulcanus contracts (3 parties: student/host company/EU-Japan Centre);  
Visa / work permit procedure, etc for the student

your future trainee attends  
1-week seminar in Brussels, on the EU institutions and EU culture

APRIL 2017

your future trainee attends  
15-week intensive course of the language spoken at your company

FROM APRIL 2017 - 3 MONTHS

--> 1st contribution (€ 3.300) to be paid by the company  
to the EU-Japan Centre, OR directly to the student,  
if a direct payment is requested by your national law (i.e. France)

MAY 2017

--> the EU-Japan Centre pays the 1st grant in Europe to the student,  
unless a direct payment by the company is requested  
by your national law (i.e. France)

JUNE 2017

8- month industrial placement  
Accommodation rented and paid for by the student

FROM AUGUST 2017 - 8 MONTHS

-->2nd contribution (€ 3.300) to be paid by the company  
to the EU-Japan Centre, OR directly to the student,  
if a direct payment is requested by your national law (i.e.  
Germany / France)

OCTOBER 2017

--> the EU-Japan Centre pays the 2nd grant in Europe to the student,  
unless a direct payment by the company is requested  
by your national law (i.e. Germany / France)

NOVEMBER 2017

End of the programme. Graduation Ceremony in Brussels.  
Attending: the students, the representatives of the host companies  
(costs of trip covered by the EU-Japan Centre), representatives of  
the EU and Japanese Institutions
