Obtaining Unified Supplier Qualification (touitsushikakushinsa) **- A practical Guide -**



Companies that wish to supply goods and services to Japanese government entities need to obtain supplier qualification in order to be eligible to take part in bid on government tenders. For national government institutions, and organisations falling directly under the jurisdiction of those institutions, the so-called Unified Supplier Qualification System or *touitsushikakushisa* exists.

This system means that prospective suppliers can apply at one of the participating institutions and will receive a qualification valid for a large number of national and regional government entities and their affiliated organizations. ([List here](#)) The application is free of charge and will take a few weeks to be processed at the most, if all documentation is present. The qualification is valid for a maximum period of three years, depending on the time the application is done. After this period, the application will need to be repeated i.e. there is no automatic renewal.

The review for the Unified Supplier Qualification will result in a classification ranging from A to D, which largely depend on the size of the company. In the majority of tenders it is stipulated which class of companies is eligible to place bids, although many tenders place no restrictions. All documentation required needs to be submitted in Japanese, foreign documents will need to have Japanese translations added.

It is possible to apply [online](#) once all documentation has been prepared. It is also possible to do part of the application online and send attached documentation separately by mail. In practice however, it is advised to do the application [in person](#) or by a representative and have the documentation checked on the spot.

Necessary documentation

The following documents need to be prepared for the application ([In case of mailed application](#)). Documents issued by public offices must be less than 3 months old and documents must be clearly printed.

Points of attention for application by foreign companies

1. In Japan people usually sign with a personal seal, this can be replaced by a signature;

2. Amounts must be written down in Japanese yen, use the exchange rate on the date of application, as stipulated by law. Look [here](#) for more information about the exchange rates.
3. The Notification of the qualifications review is in principle only sent within Japan. If no office is present in Japan, please apply via a letter of attorney and a representative. Please note here that the notifications have been sent to offices abroad.

How to fill in the application

In the following it is explained how to fill in the application. It is however strongly recommended to have a person knowledgeable with the Japanese language to fill in the documents. The JT&PP Helpdesk can assist you with this.

Application period

There is usually a set period for application in January, but it is also possible to apply outside of this period. If you apply within the set period, the qualification will be valid for the whole three years. Outside of this period it will be valid for the remainder of the period of three years. The application form to be used during the set period can be found [here](#) (Excel), the application used outside of the set period is found [here](#) (PDF). Submitting the application

Where to submit

The application and related documents can be submitted to the relevant office at each of the participating government institutions. You can only submit an application at one location. The addresses can be found (*In Japanese*) on the '['chotatsujoho' website](#)'. If you are already planning to tender at a specific department, you can find the address in the searchable database, by typing in the postal code, (part of) the address or the numerical code of the institution. This will then produce a list of

possible options. In case you have not yet decide to bid for a certain tender, then select the central government office you expect to participate in tenders. If you have difficulty finding the address, or you cannot read the Japanese pages, get in touch with our Helpdesk or call one of the [contact points on public procurement](#).

Sending the application

If you send the documents by mail, it is advised to send them by registered mail to ensure delivery. It is however recommended to hand in the documentation in person, to have it checked on the spot.

Unified Qualifications Helpdesk

The Helpdesk is not used to deal with inquiries from abroad, so it is advisable to have a Japanese speaker doing this for you.

Receipt of Notification

The notification ([click here for sample with explanation](#)) will take a number of weeks to arrive. It will depend on the number of applications the Administration Center receives. The notifications are sent by regular mail, so it might take longer to arrive, if sent to an address abroad.

Company registration documents

Japan has its own company registration system, the Business registry. If you are register as a company in Japan you should submit a copy of the Certificate of registered matter (登記事項証明書) This guide assumes that your company is not registered in Japan. In this case you should submit a similar document issued by the legal authority in your country, in charge of business registration, such as the company registry or trade registry.

Financial statements

It must be possible to ascertain capital and net total amount of assets, as can be ascertained in the case of Japanese companies. If it is not possible to make financial statements available publicly, please get in touch with the office where you are applying, for individual treatment of your application.

Financial statements are statements made by the company itself or an accountant, such as a balance sheet, profit and loss statement, Statement of shareholders equity; Statement of net assets changes, operating statement and breakdown of assets and liabilities.

In the case of individuals, it can be an income tax return statement.

- In case of corporations, please submit a settled account of business
- In case of individuals, it must be a document provided by the tax office, trial balance sheets are not accepted.

Business record/history

These are documents provided by the company, such as corporate history, outline of number of employees, business line, business locations (Main offices, branch offices, representative offices in re region where mainly contracts are concluded) If above information is in a brochure this is accepted as well) Information must be no more

than one years old. This is free form, however a [template](#) (with explanation) is provided.

Letter of attorney (If applicable)

In case you are using a local representative for the application you will need to submit a letter of attorney. Sample (with explanation is provided [here](#)).

Documents pertaining payment of taxes in your country

If you have paid taxes in Japan, please send a copy of one of the following

- It is also possible to submit copies of E-tax statements.

Gaijitodoke

In case your company name, address and name of representative contain characters that are not listed in the JIS first and second class standard([JIS X 0208:1997](#)) it is necessary to file this document. (letters with apostrophe, umlaut etc. are regarded as 'foreign letters) Template with explanation is available [here](#).

Clarification regarding depreciation of leased capital (If applicable)

If you wish to apply for a qualification to supply manufactured goods and you have listed leased capital in the financial statement, in order to establish the actual state of the production facilities. Please submit detailed documents regarding the depreciation and rest value of the leased capital.

Calculating into Japanese yen

Applicants are obligated to fill in monetary amounts in Japanese yen and use officially designated exchange rates. These rates differ from daily market prices. The official exchange rates are found at http://www.mof.go.jp/about_mof/act/kokuji_tsuutatsu/kokuji/KO-20130206-0029-14.htm Make sure that the valid exchange rate corresponds with the date that you submit your application. If you do not recalculate your financial figures according to these rates, your application will be refused.
