

EU-Japan Business Round Table Press Release

Paris, Wednesday 17 April 2013

Announcement of a Press Conference of the EU-Japan Business Round Table on 30 April at 12:30 at the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs 27 Rue de la Convention, 75015 Paris

The EU-Japan Business Round Table (BRT), a forum of around 50 European and Japanese business leaders co-chaired by Messrs. Jean-Yves Le Gall (Chairman & CEO of Arianespace) and Hiromasa Yonekura (Chairman of Sumitomo Chemical Co., Ltd.), will meet in Paris on 29 & 30 April 2013 for its 15th Annual Meeting.

The meeting's agenda will include discussions on the just-started negotiations towards an EU-Japan FTA/EPA and an agreement covering political, global and sectoral cooperation. EU and Japanese business leaders will also exchange views on EU-Japan cooperation, including business with / in emerging economies and resources issues such as energy, materials and innovation. The members expect to have high-level discussions with senior representatives of the EU and Japanese Authorities.

A press conference will be held immediately after the meeting on Tuesday 30 April, from 12:30 to 13:00 at the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Rue de la Convention, Paris. Mr. Fabrice Brégier, President & CEO of Airbus (in-coming EU-side BRT Chairman), will participate in the press conference.
